We have today been advised by a person who attended the Organised Open Play Bowling on the evening of Wednesday 11th March 2020 that they have decided to self-isolate, having returned from a cruise to Norway with flu-like symptoms.

According to current advice from Public Health England, even if the case were to be confirmed, the likelihood of anyone else attending on the evening of Wednesday 11th March 2020 contracting the virus is extremely low.

Although current cleaning procedures are deemed adequate to protect visitors to the Centre, we are, through an abundance of caution, carrying out additional cleaning routines in response to this.

The Centre remains open and as per government advice we continue to operate normally, with a high level of vigilance.

It is for each individual to determine the risk to themselves of the presence of this virus within our community and take what steps they feel appropriate to protect themselves.
